IDT conferences are for IDT enthusiasts of all types. Whether you have a 'head, heart or gut' predisposition, one of the remarkable things about IDT is its adaptability and application across an outstanding range of uses. Besides introducing you to some of the innovative and provocative things different people are doing with IDT, our 2008 conference will have an underlying theme about the way that the masculine and feminine contribute to therapeutic success or therapeutic avoidance.

- How do I enact the distinction between therapeutic mothering and therapeutic fathering?

The Tauhara Centre overlooks Lake Taupo (centre of the North Island) and is a stunning venue, well-known for its uplifting ambience and great service. We're in for a treat!

TRAVEL If you are flying in, Taupo is a small provincial airport about 15 mins from Tauhara by taxi or shuttle bus. If coming from Australia, you'll need to transfer via Auckland or Wellington. Book early to secure a seat.

ACCOMMODATION Tauhara provides 10 x 4-berth bunk-rooms (which we have booked and will allocate on a "first-enrolled first-reserved" basis). If these get fully taken up (as they have in the past) or you prefer to have your own room, then you'll need to arrange your own accommodation elsewhere. Taupo Visitors Centre (Ph +64 7 376 0027) has motels listed (Taupo township is only a 10 minute drive from Tauhara). You can google up 'NZ Holiday Homes and Baches' for private listings if you want to stay with colleagues. Westerman Real Estate (Ph +64 7 378 6163) also rent several private houses. The Great Lake Holiday Park (Ph 07 378 5159) has cabins 3km away on Acacia Bay Road. You might be able to arrange private accommodation elsewhere at Tauhara itself. Note that you'll need to arrange your own daily transport if staying off-site.

WHAT TO BRING Dress is casual. Bring walking shoes, swimming togs and rain jacket (for a hot-river wallow or river-side walk). Bring music discs, a symbolic object that represents your gender interests, some clarity, some longing, a bottle or two of refreshment to share at dinners and our party, any informational flyers or items of IDT interest that you'd like to display in our Networking corner, bring your gender-selected party outfit with all accessories for Saturday night. (NB. We'll provide boards, crayons, paper, etc).

CERTIFICATES Conference is traditionally a time to publicly award recent IDT Certificates, so get any outstanding assignments finished and send them into the office ASAP.
